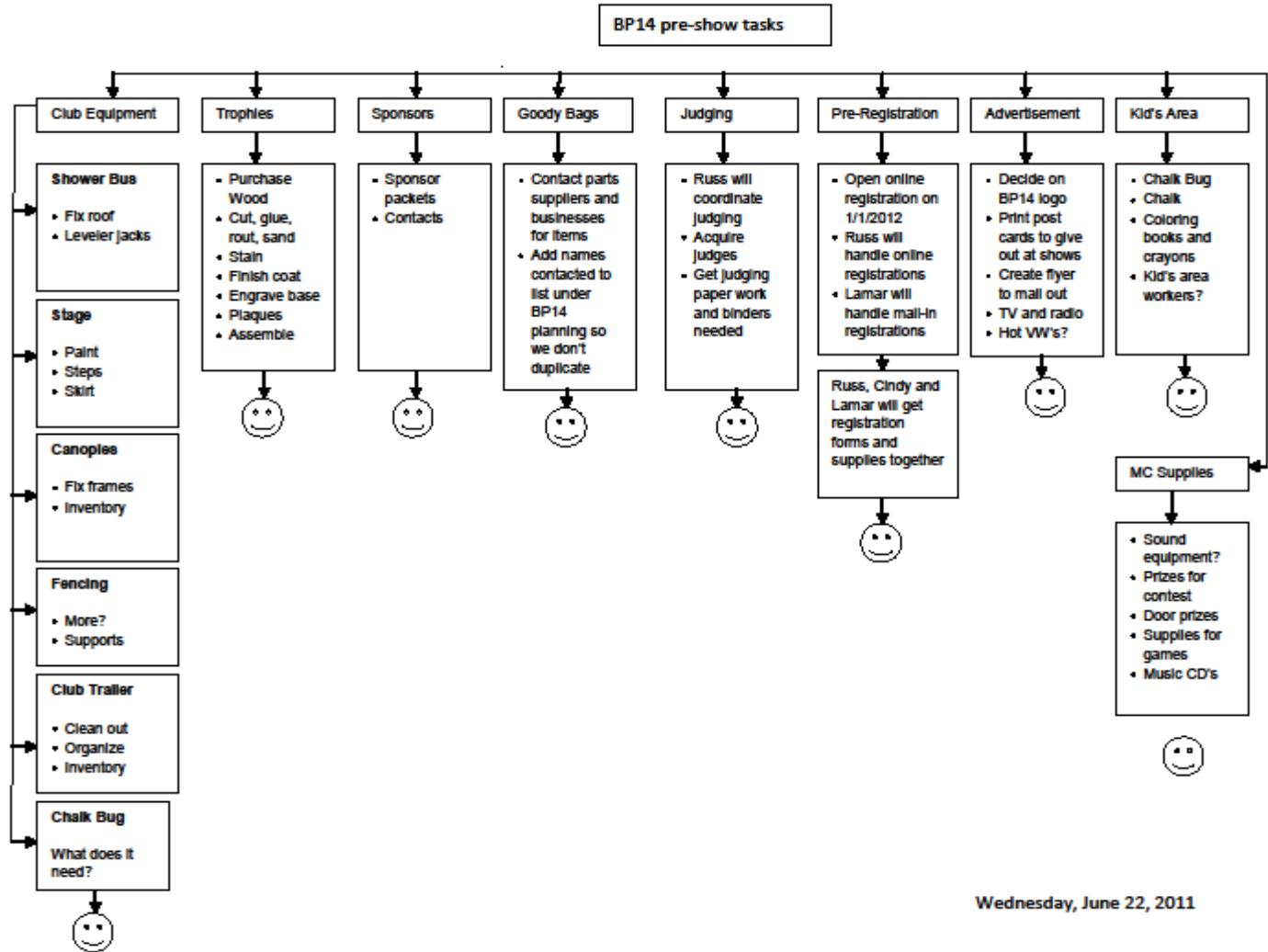
Scenic City Volks Folks cruise-in, August 5th at 7:00 p.m. (Sonic on East Brainerd Road)
